With reference to your application on the subject noted above, I am directed to grant recognition to your school under section 4 of the Delhi School Education Act, 1973 from Class ... I... to ...VIII.... (without aid) w.e.f the academic session ...2001-2002.. subject to fulfilment of the following terms and conditions:-

- That the school shall abide by the provision of Delhi School Education Act, 1973 and 1. Rules framed thereunder as well as the instructions issued by the Directorate of Education from time to time.
- That the school shall admit students without any discrimination of religion, race, caste 2. or place of birth as per the norms of the Department.
- That the school shall appoint full time qualified and eligible staff as per the norms of 3. the Department.
- That the school shall equip the science lab. as per the norms of the Department and 4. suitable facilities for practical work shall be provided to the students.
- More science goods worth Rs. 5000/- shall be purchased during the current year and a 5. list be furnished to the Education Officer for verification within a year of the date of recognition.
- That a proper library shall be established and facilities for reading room shall also be 6. made available for students as well as teachers. Books as per the ratio of ten books per students may be provided and facilities of reading room shall also be provided immediately and more books worth Rs. 5000/- be purchased by the start of the next Education furnished books list of session Officer for verification. Adequate sports material shall be purchased and made available to the students immediately.

Rules, 1973 and payment will be made as per section 10(1) of Delhi School Education Act, 1973 read with 126 of the Rules to all the employees by crossed cheque. That the enrolment in each section shall not exceed the number of students calculated 8. @ 10 Sq.ft per student for the available floor area of the classroom and the school shall provide adequate and sufficient accommodation as per the norms of the Directorate of Education, Delhi in each class. That the school shall dispense with the services of unqualified and over-aged staff, if 9. any, immediately. That the Govt, nominees on the Managing committee to be constituted as per the 10. approved scheme will be asked for immediately. The Managing committee of the school shall not enhance the fee during the ensuing 11. academic session without the prior approval of the Director of Education. The Managing Committee shall regulate the functioning of the school strictly in 12. accordance with the provisions of the Act and the rules. That all the facilities prescribed under Rule 50 & 51 of the D.S.E.R., 1973 shall be 13. made available to the students That the arrangement of good drinking water shall be made available to all the 14. students/teachers and sanitary facilities shall also be provided to the students. Fresh Health Certificate may be obtained from the MCD within a month and be 15. submitted to the Education Officer for verification. That the Managing Committee of the school shall create a reserve fund equivalent to 16. three months salary or Rs. 1.00 Lakh + Rs. 80/- per student whichever is less in a joint account in the name of the undersigned and the Manager of the school in a scheduled bank within three months. Proof to the effect that the staff has been appointed as per the recruitment rules be 17. provided to the Education Officer for verification. That the copies of the appointment letter issued to the staff be provided for 18. verification. That the school shall not run any unrecognized classes or any other activities within the school premises and all the recognized classes shall be run at the place at the 19. above address only. Arrears of pay etc. due to pay fixation of V pay Commission Report, 1996 remaining 20. unpaid shall be paid immediately. Provident Fund register be maintained and cash book be completed and shown to 21. Education Officer of the zone for verification from time to time. Whomby!

That the school shall strictly abide by the provisions of Delhi School education Act &

That the violation of any instruction/orders/conditions/rules and regulation of the Department shall lead to the Withdrawal of recognition of the school and class IX shall not be opened without the prior approval of the Director of Education.

- 23. The school building does have the sanctioned plan pass by the local authority. Recognition has been granted to the school owing to the demand of school in the area and, as such, this recognition is without prejudice to the claim of regularization of the school building or its demolition on account of the structure being unauthorized and in that event this Directorate may be intimated to make alternative arrangement for the students studying in the school.
- 24. That a report of the fulfillment of the conditions giving the extent to which each condition has been fulfilled shall be sent to the Education Officer every six months.
- 25. That the school shall not start Class IX in the school before it is recognized by the Department and in the case of this happening, the recognition granted to the school lapse under rule 55(2) of DSER, 1973.
